ETHICS

The publication of an article/research paper/case studies in this journal is platform in building in the growth & development of a rational and valued the universe of knowledge. Therefore it is important to agree on maintaining the standards of expected ethical behavior.

ETHICS TOPICS TO CONSIDER FOR PUBLISHING:

AUTHORSHIP: Authorship should be limited to those who have made a significant contribution to the conception, design, execution, or interpretation of the reported study.

ORIGINALITY AND PLAGIARISM: The authors should ensure that they have written entirely original works, and if the authors have used the work and/or words of others, that this has been appropriately cited or quoted.

DATA ACCESS AND RETENTION: Authors may be asked to provide the raw data in connection with a paper for editorial review, and should be prepared to provide public access to such data.

MULTIPLE, REDUNDANT OR CONCURRENT PUBLICATION:

An author should not in general publish manuscripts describing essentially the same research in more than one journal or primary publication. IJLMS does not view the following uses of a work as prior publication: publication in the form of an abstract; publication as an academic thesis; publication as an electronic preprint. Information on prior publication is included within journal's Guide for Authors.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF SOURCES: Proper acknowledgment.

DISCLOSURE AND CONFLICTS OF INTEREST: All submissions must include disclosure of all relationships that could be viewed as presenting a potential conflict of interest.

FUNDAMENTAL ERRORS IN PUBLISHED WORKS: When an author discovers a significant error or inaccuracy in his/her own published work, it is the author's obligation to promptly notify the journal editor or publisher and cooperate with the editor to retract or correct the paper.

REPORTING STANDARDS: Authors of reports of original research should present an accurate account of the work performed as well as an objective discussion of its significance.
